



Paradise or Paradiski? A five-minute ride on the world's largest cable car merges the previously-separate ski areas of Les Arcs and La Plagne into Paradiski, a skier's paradise. Either resort has sufficient skiing on its own, but together there are 164 lifts and 260 miles of long snow-sure trails, beginning above the tree line and leading into lower wooded areas.

Scattered among the slopes are separate small villages varying in design and character; some ancient and traditional, others modern and functional. In this environment, Intrawest has built Arc 1950, a stylish low-rise ski-in ski-out village of rustic condos, shops, restaurants and bars surrounding an active pedestrian precinct.
